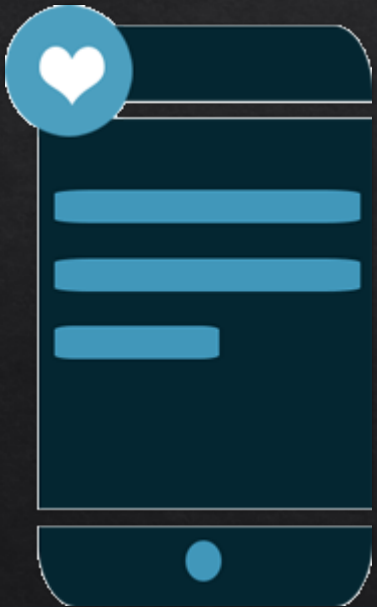
Welcome
