from being anchored in You.

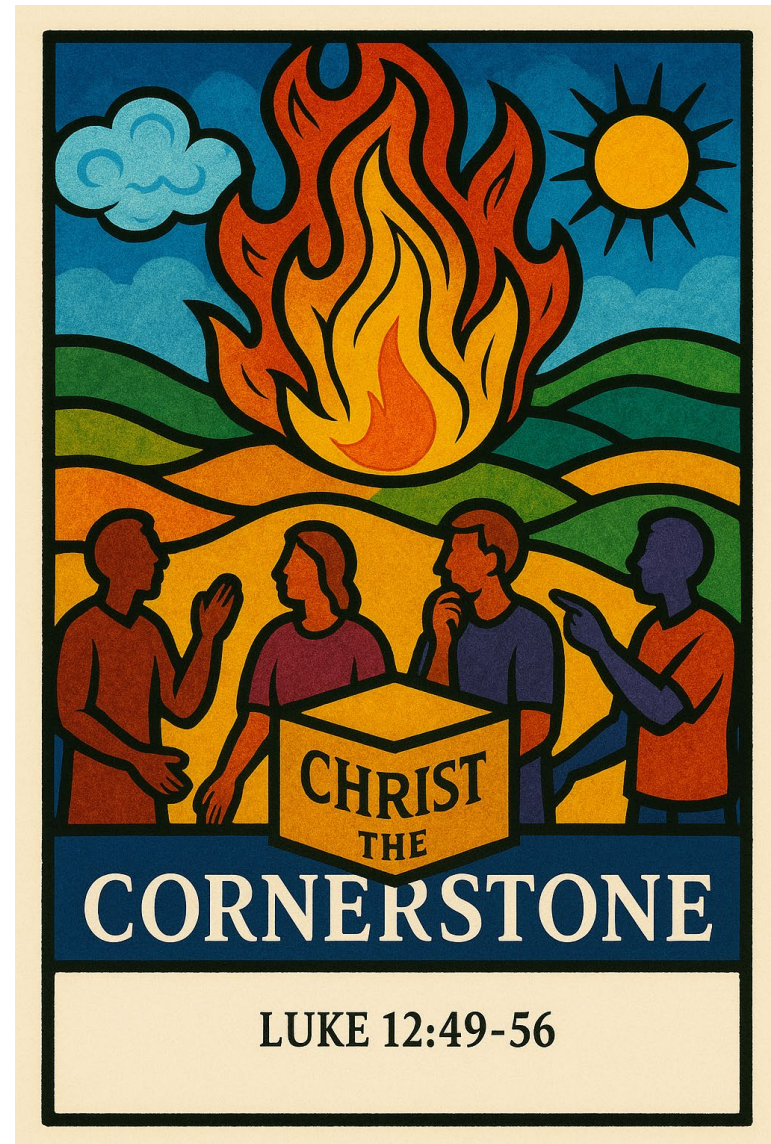
