Amen.

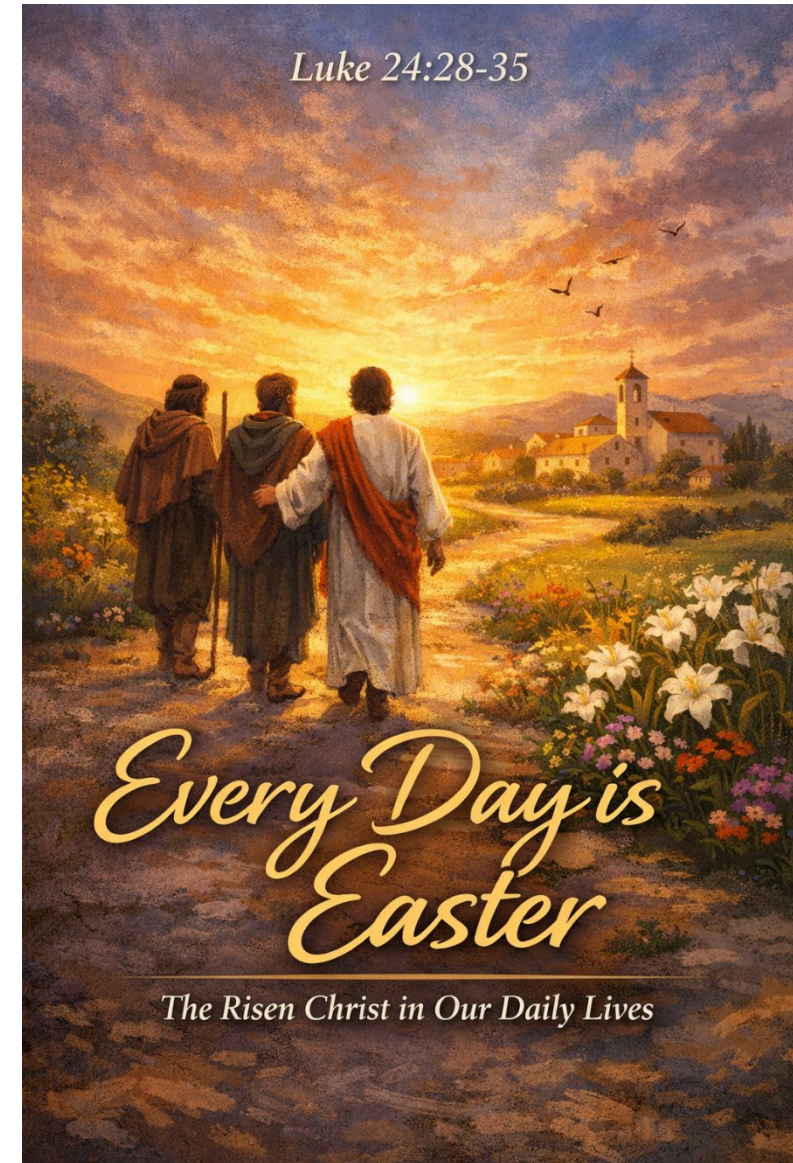
