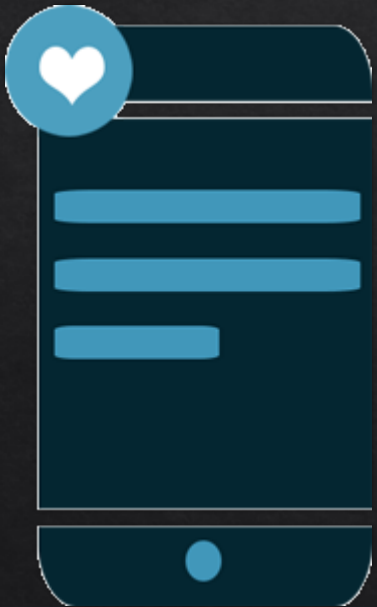
Welcome

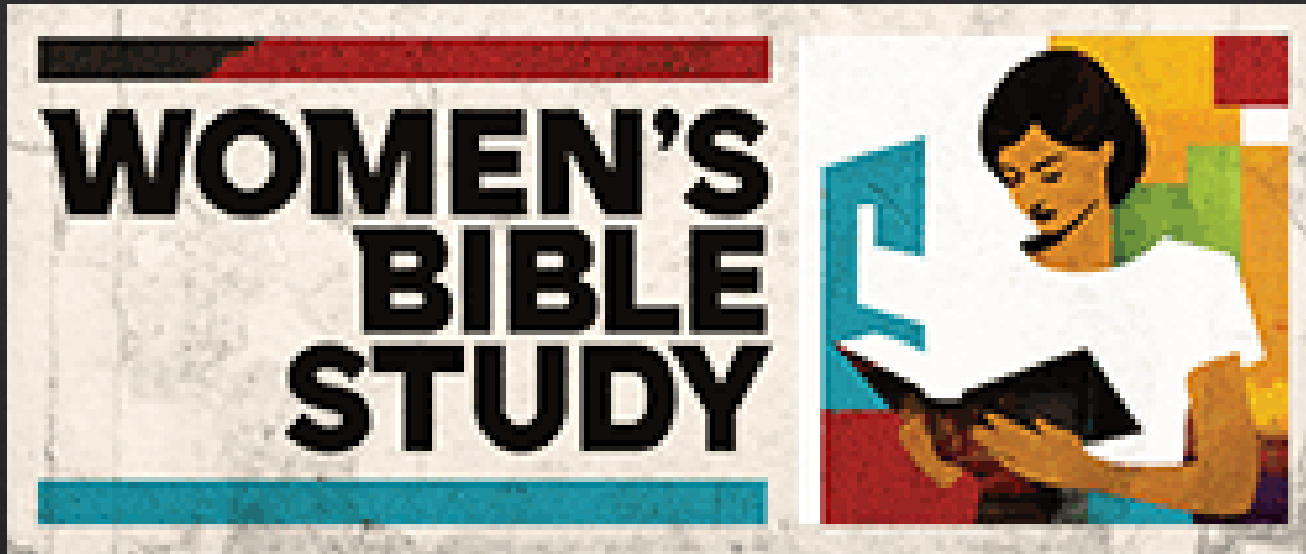

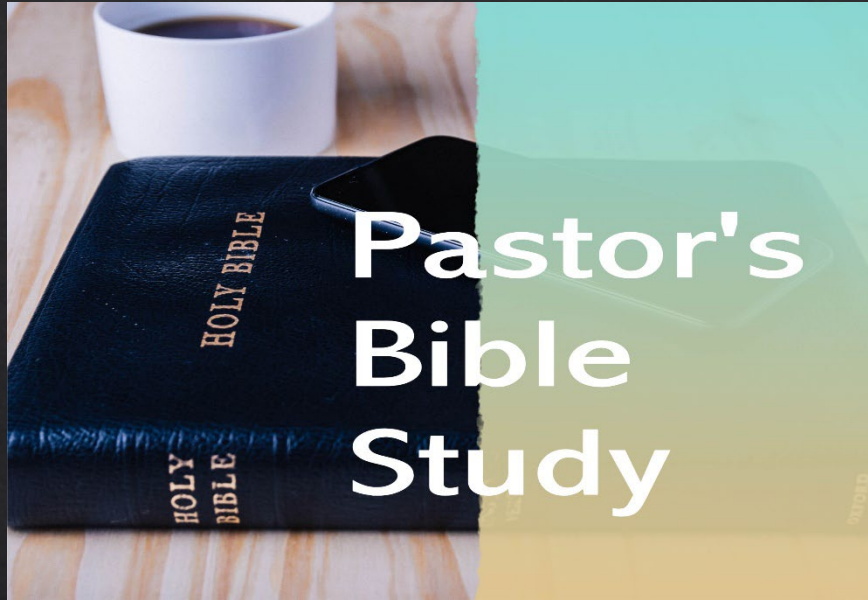

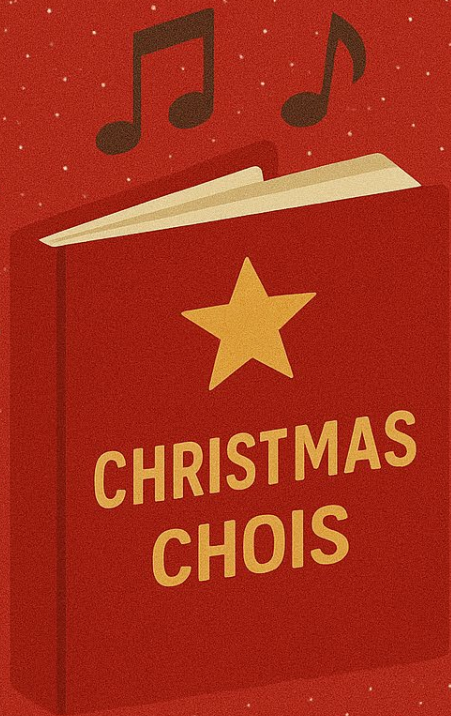
